The MotorCities National Heritage Area encompasses over 10,000 square miles in southeast and central Michigan.

MotorCities links the world's largest collection of cultural and labor organizations, museums, archives, factories, auto collections and events to preserve the story of how auto and labor helped build the middle class while transforming manufacturing worldwide.

They work to inspire residents and visitors of southeast and central Michigan with an appreciation for how the automobile changed Michigan, the nation, and the world.

The MotorCities Markers are part of a comprehensive system of over 250 outdoor exhibits throughout central and southeastern Michigan. Each sign commemorates and brings awareness to Michigan's automotive heritage on both a community and regional level.

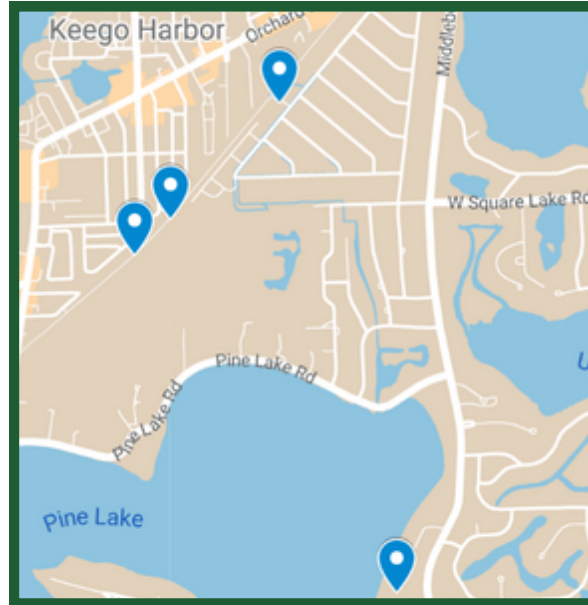
# MotorCities Markers Locations

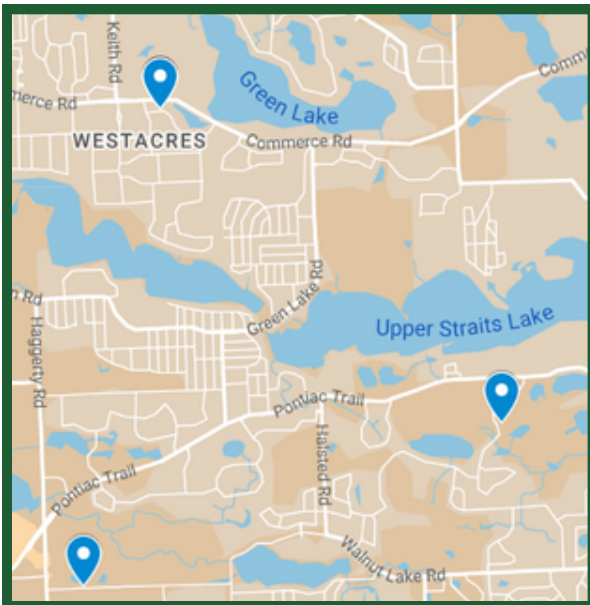

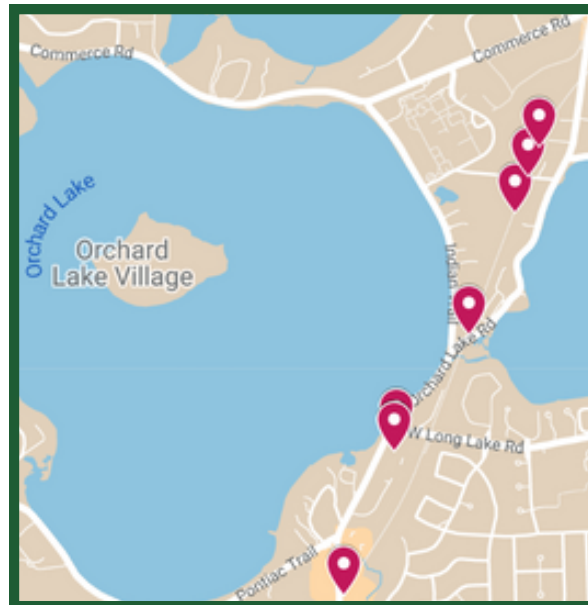
